In addition, employees have another voluntary health benefit – free training in Transcendental Meditation (TM). Over 50% of employees have taken advantage of this unique opportunity and everyone has access to a quiet room for meditation and state of the art fitness centers to make a healthy lifestyle present and convenient.
